REQUEST FOR ROAD PROJECT BIDS

The Town of Oakfield is seeking sealed bids for a road resurfacing project and four road sealcoating projects.

The resurfacing project consists of an approximate 1.0 mile section of Prairie Road, east of Fountain Road. The project will involve the addition of 4 inches of $\frac{3}{4}$ inch road gravel lift, the pulverizing of the existing asphalt with the added gravel including shaping and compacting to a width of 20 ft., the placement of a compacted 2 inch hot-mix asphalt mat with the addition of 2 ft. wide gravel shoulders.

The 4 sealcoating projects consist of the following:

- 1) .24 mile section of Schoepke Road from Highland Road west to the end.
- 2) .66 mile section of Oak Center Road from N3244 north to County Road D.
- 3) .65 mile section of Wolf Road from HWY 151 south to Prairie Road.
- 4) .50 mile section of Prairie Road from Wolf Road east to Fountain Road.

The hot-mix asphalt shall be bid on a per ton price for material laid in place and compacted. Material shall meet Wisconsin DOT specifications for moderate volume roads. The pulverizing of existing pavement, shaping and compacting shall be bid on a square yard price, with a total price for the project. Gravel material shall be bid on a per ton basis for both the base and shoulders. Sealcoating shall be bid on a per mile basis, with a separate quote for any recommended patching. Contractors are to supply all labor, material, traffic control, signing and proof of insurance.

The Town of Oakfield reserves the right to reject any or all bids or part of bids and accept any bid, which in the judgment of the Town Board, may be most advantageous to the Town. Bids will be publicly opened and acted upon at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday,

May 20, 2015 at the Town Hall in Oak Center. The bidders are reminded that the work must be completed to State of Wisconsin DOT standards.
